- I. Tricia Biocini called meeting to order at 7:10 pm.
- II. Last Board Meeting Minutes were unanimously approved.
- III. President's report:
  - Goalie Clinic will be September 16<sup>th</sup> from 1-3.
  - All teams, especially new ones coming in to the league, have to have open tryouts.
  - There is a mandatory coach meeting coming. The city wants everyone to hear the rules and if a coach doesn't attend, the team can't use the Soccer Park.
- IV. Vice President's Report:
  - The Soccer Park is available the same days as last year, Tu / Th. The grass field will be closed for 5 weeks for re-seeding and the whole park is closed the weekend of Art and Wine.
- V. Registrar's Report:
  - 1357 players were registered. 973 were recreation league
- VI. Referee's Report:
  - 10 teams are signed up for a total of 5 games each day
  - 30 new refs. attended the clinic, 12 of whom were adults.
- VII. Volunteer Report:
  - Tournament Field Marshall's are the only FMs that are allowed to collect VPP.
  - Paul Stevens made a motion to allow reimbursement for up to 2 Assistant Coaches per team U8 and up and David Burke seconded. **Unanimously approved.**
- VIII. Field Striping:
  - Matt Heinz has someone interested in the striping job. Board recommends \$140 / week, max \$2,000 for season.
- IX. Picture Coordinator:
  - Picture day is 9/16. We need 20 volunteers for that day to make four shifts of 5 to cover 8:00-4:00. She also needs 5 volunteers for make up picture day.
- X. Coordinators' Reports
  - U6 needs 9 coaches
  - U8 needs 1
  - U10 has all coaches but is short some equipment
  - U12 has 21 teams and needs a U16 coach.
- XI. Tournament Director's Report:
  - Rotary Cup will have 96 teams and 5 fields: Millikin, Curtis, Wilson, Central Park, and the Soccer Park.
- XII. DelGado / Player Development Report:
  - Manny volunteered to be Delgado rep. for the rest of the year.
  - Web Site – Dan Gisi made a motion to upgrade the Website. This would change the monthly cost from \$20 to \$49. Manny seconded. **Unanimously approved.**
